It would take around 29 years to visit one new Aussie beach every day.

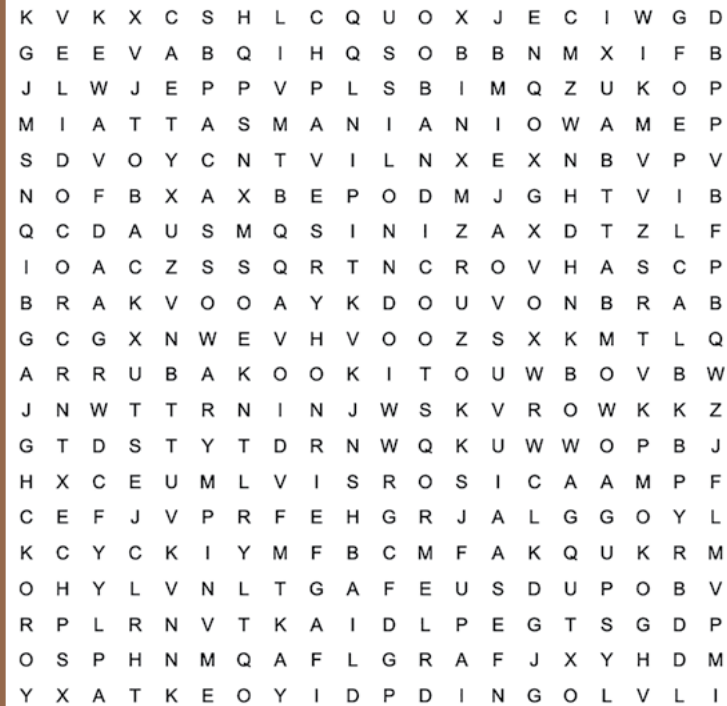
Australia's Great Barrier Reef is the planet's largest living structure.

Approximately 1.3 billion litres of wine are produced each year in Australia.

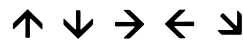
The Australian Alps actually receive more snow each year than Switzerland.

Last month, we celebrated 50 years of manufacturing Mesabi® products in Australia at our Perth, WA facility. It was a wonderful party with current, former and retired employees in attendance. It also kicked off the completion of the new building that will house our aluminum/brass tube-making processes – which we've been working to bring to Australia for a few years.

L&M Radiator, Pty. Ltd. started in tiny Wagin, Western Australia, in 1972 (when your author was just six years old!), in a 2,000 square foot factory with just five employees.

In 1974, the company moved to Planet Street in Welshpool, a suburb of Perth, for a few years to a 4,000 square-foot facility until settling on our current site in 1977. Since then, the L&M Australia team has been growing and adding to their capabilities to produce nearly all of our Mesabi® products. The site has been added to, upgraded, renovated and remodeled to the current state-

of-the-art production facility, encompassing nearly 60,000 square feet of production space, employing 177 great people and producing about \$3.9 million Australian per month.

The party kicked off with champagne, an oyster bar and passed 'nibbles' along with a band before serving chicken and lamb sliders and fish and chips to more than 250 guests. We were pleased to see many old friends and new ones, too—this is what makes L&M such a special place. General Manager Richard Chapell spoke about the history of L&M Australia and introduced former General Manager John Haymes, now 91 years young, who retired for the last time in 1992, when Richard took over in that role.
