I ordered a chicken and an egg from Amazon. I'll let you know.

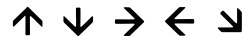
I was playing chess with my friend and he said, "Let's make this interesting." So we stopped playing chess.

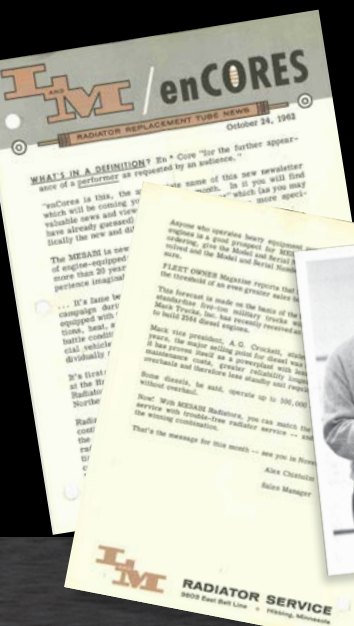
